In the spring semester, there is a musical for students in grades 9-12 (younger students can be added, depending on the show selected).

The position includes planning and executing rehearsals, working with a producer, choreographer, and music director (as needed) to be sure the shows are a positive learning experience for the students. All aspects of the production will be managed by the Director.

Requirements

All teachers must have:

- 1. A heart for God. They will be born-again, Bible-believing Christians in a growing relationship with our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
- 2. A love for children. They will be kind, nurturing individuals who enjoy spending time with young people.
- 3. An ability to be a positive role model. They will do their best to live a life that is pleasing to God and therefore serve as a model for our young people.
- 4. A call on his or her life to be a teacher. They will feel that teaching is one of their spiritual gifts and feel a call on their lives to teach and impact the next generation of Christ followers.
- 5. A dedication to the vision and mission of Arborbrook. They will have a thorough understanding of and be in agreement with the vision and mission of the school.
- 6. A teachable spirit. They must be open to training from a supervising teacher and the academic director. A positive attitude and cheerful demeanor should accompany their teachable spirit.
- 7. Experience as a director.
